Installation

The Touch Screen Control may be installed anywhere in the room away from the fireplace, and is only limited by the length of the 50 foot CAT5 cable provided with the fireplace. The Touch screen Control mounts into a 3 Gang plastic electrical box (pre-installed before sheetrock) or a 3 Gang low-voltage mounting bracket (installed directly into sheetrock). A 3 Gang plastic electrical box is provided with this kit.

Install either one into the wall and route the Cat5 cable from the fireplace into the box or bracket.

Installation:

Locate the 3 Gang Plastic Electrical Box up to the length of the CAT5 cable(50ft) away from the fireplace next to a wall stud. Anchor the box to the wall stud (or other framing structure) with screws driven through the factory-made holes in the back or side tabs of the box, as applicable.

Route the CAT5 cable up into the box.

Finish the wall with drywall.





Route the end of the CAT5 cable out through the opening from in the drywall. Plug the CAT5 cable into the Switch Board socket as shown.

Caution: The electrical power supply to the fireplace must be disconected prior to connectingordisconnecting the CAT5 cable.

Orient the control's Mounting Frame so that the small arrow is pointing up. Place the Mounting Frame into the opening.

Attach the Frame with 4 screws provided.

Remove the yellow strip from the battery mount.

Orient the Display Assembly so that the small arrow is pointing up.

Plug the 6 wire connector from the Switch Board into the Display Assembly board socket.

Install the Display into the opening until the magnets grab hold.

The magnets hold the Display Assembly in place.

Peel the protective film off the face of the Display and discard.

Finally, restore electrical power supply to the fireplace. Once the power is back ON, the new Touch Control display will take up to a full minute to boot-up before its ready to control the fireplace.

Operation

The fireplace Flame and Lights are easily controlled with the Digital Touch Screen. The screen takes approximately one (1) minute to boot up after electrical powers supply is turned ON.

If the screen is dark (in the sleep mode), touch the screen once anywhere on the screen to wake it up.

Main Screen

The Main screen has several lcons which are used to navigate to various sub-menus and a Master icon to turn the fireplace ON and OFF



- Flame On/Off
- 2. Flame High/Low
- 3. Lights (White) On/Off
- 4. Lights Dimmer High to Low
- 5. Lights Color On/Off
 - RGB Spectrum Select
 - Colour Loop On/Off
 - Return to Main Screen

Flame & Light Settings Screen

To access the Flame & Light Setting screen, touch the Flame & Light Setting icon (2). From this screen, each of the items can be controlled separately.

When any function is ON, the corresponding icon is colored. If the function is OFF, the corresponding icon is grey. Once any of the items are turned ON and preset to the desired setting, they can be turned OFF and ON with the Master Switch icon on the Main screen.

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Settings

From the Main Screen, Touch the Settings icon (2) to access Settings Screen. From here, you can access the following:

Network > Home Automation setting

System > Date and Time settings Preferences > Timer Settings Device > Display and About Diagnostics > Inlet and Manifold Pressure

Home Automation:

Turn ON the Home Automation icon if the fireplace is to be operated with a Home Automation system.

System:

Set the date and time for the system. To set the time, rotate the dial icon to the correct hour, Once released, it will then switch to the minutes screen, Set the minutes by rotating the dial icon to the correct minutes setting.

Set the date by selecting month and day.

Preferences:

Timer function will turn the fireplace ON and OFF twice a day and 7 days a week.

Set the ON time and OFF time individual for each day of the week. Each day can have up to 2 ON/ OFF cycles.

Devices:

Set the Display brightness by Touch the Display icon to adjust screen brightness. Slide the icon left or right to adjust screen brightness.

The About Device displays information device information.

Diagnostics:

Displays Inlet and Manifold gas pressure.

Temperature Sensor:

The Touch Screen Control has a temperature sensor built in which will shut the system OFF if the room temperature exceeds 40°C / 104°F.

System Disable Switch:

System Disable switch located at the left side of the Display. This switch turns OFF the appliance controls until such time that it is turned back ON.
